

InnovaBalt manager, Professor Maija Dambrova participated in the workshop „Contribution of "Research Potential" (REGPOT) and "Regions of Knowledge" (ROK), the way forward thanks to synergies between EU policies/funds”, Brussels (BE), 07.12.2015.

In the EC organized workshop there were 3 show-cases of RegPot projects and among them also Professor Maija Dambrova presented achievements of the InnovaBalt project: how the Latvian Institute of Organic Synthesis (IOS) manages to build/create synergies between Structural Funds and Research Framework Programme and complementarities between two funds. It was concluded that in synergy to different EU Structural Fund activities the InnovaBalt project improves the organization and quality of science in IOS in terms of know-how and providing new technologies, the InnovaBalt project activities enhance IOS capacities in the academia – industry R&D collaborations. The collaboration across European borders has already resulted in new projects and publications and contributed to the socioeconomic development of the Baltic region. The InnovaBalt project activities and possibilities of collaboration in future were discussed with researchers from Poland, Czech Republic, Croatia and Sweden.
